I've been telling y'all that 2020 was going to be an interesting year. I just didn't think it would be this interesting! As much as state-wide policies of self-isolation have been a real pain, I continue to see God's Spirit at work throughout our congregation. So many of you have stepped forward to support each other; thank you!

One of the many silver linings of March has been how quickly our congregation has adapted to communicating online. In only two weeks we went from having zero experience hosting worship online to doing it with nearly three dozen people in attendance.

Dennis & Maryel R. are keeping the prayer team active through Zoom meetings as well as working on ways to add music to our Sunday worship services.

Another silver lining is that we now have two additional online gatherings each week: Bible Study on Tuesdays at 6:00 pm and "Coffee with the Pastor" on Thursdays at 6:00 pm. Once again, we're using Zoom for these meetings.

To maintain a steady flow of information to as many people as possible, I've created an online emailing database using the MailChimp platform (which is free for us; I love free). I'm thrilled to report that we already have 80 verified email addresses in there. This is a major step forward in solidifying our digital presence.

For the past few months, I've been working with Mandy & Mark S. who are following God's tuggings in their lives. Mandy is getting involved with several teams and is a fountain of "what if..." ideas. I love it!

Mark is sensing God calling him into new levels of spiritual and leadership growth. He just started the first of four classes in the UMC's Certified Lay Ministry program. This will be a blessing for all of us. To give you a teaser, (and in addition to the Men's Bible Study that he is initiating) Mark and I are already discussing leading our church through several of the "Lay Servant" classes. Stay tuned!

with a few of our members at home as well as serve communion to our faithful group at Eagle Lake Village. Speaking of which...



#### **Check Out the New Features!**

In the top left corner, you'll see a "Connect" tab. The first item on the list is "Contact Us." This is where the public can send the office a message.

The second item down is "Prayer Requests" which is the perfect place for anyone to submit their prayer concerns. While we are unable to meet in person for Sunday worship, we highly encourage you to utilize this page. Our prayer warriors look forward to receiving your prayers of thanks, praise, and requests.

The third item down is "**About Us**" which has been recently updated to include a brief history of the church. If you have additional information about our church's history and/or photos of the church, please contact Pastor Charles so that he can add that content to this page.

Next down is our "**Staff**" page. Often, people who are considering visiting a church look at the

staff page so they can learn more about the people they are likely to meet if and when they visit.

Finally, we have the "Pastor's Blog" page. This is where you can find links to Pastor Charles' sermons which include links to Scripture readings, artwork, handouts, etc.

The "f' in the top right corner of the website takes you directly to our Facebook page.
